Report abuse of an older person or adult with disability in their family, home and community to the Ageing and Disability Commission.

# Why you would contact the Ageing and Disability Commission

## You may have noticed an older person or adult with disability:

- Is being told how to spend their money.
- Is unable to explain bruises, cuts or injuries on their body.
- Is unable to speak freely with you at appointments, especially when another person is present.
- Indicated a family member, friend or someone they know in the community had hit, threatened or sexually abused them.

#### What happens when you call us?

- Speak with a trained professional about your concerns.
- Get information on what services are available to help.
- Be supported to make a report, and be heard without judgement.
