




Reports about adults with disability **most commonly involved the parent*** as the subject of allegation.

The most commonly reported types of abuse towards older people were financial abuse, verbal abuse, failure to meet support needs.`



The most commonly reported types of abuse towards adults with disability were withholding person's money, failure to meet support needs and verbal abuse.`


