
## **Tweed Shire**






The Ageing & Disability Commission (ADC) received 52 reports related to allegations or concerns of abuse, neglect or exploitation of an older person or adult with disability from Tweed in 2020\*.



\* Information taken from the Ageing & Disability Commission data collected between 1 January - 31 December 2020 where the location of the adult identified in the report was known.
