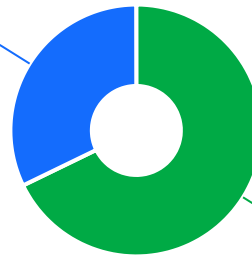


The Ageing & Disability Commission (ADC) received 87 reports of alleged abuse, neglect or exploitation of an older person or adult with disability from Albury in 2020-2022*.

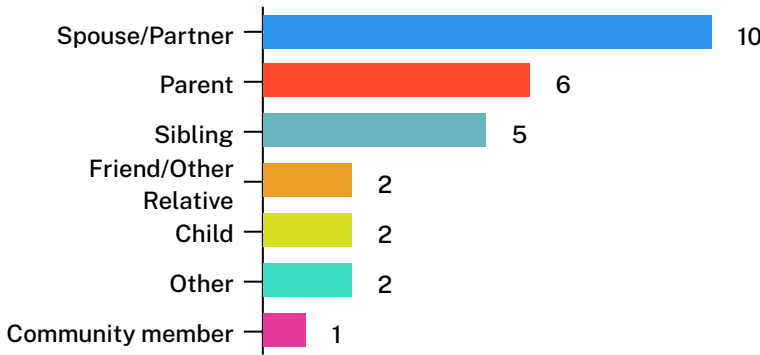

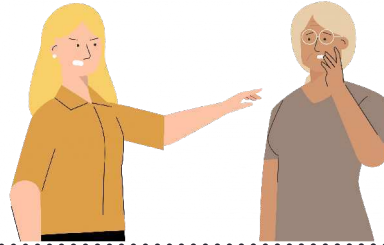

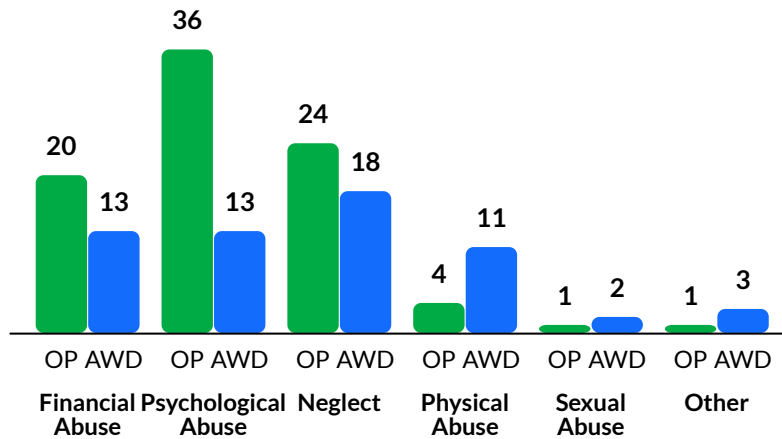
Reports about adult with disability most commonly involved a spouse or partner* as the subject of allegation



93% of reports about older people involved family members, mainly adult children followed by the adult's spouse or partner,* as the subject of allegation



The most commonly reported type of abuse towards older people (OP) was verbal abuse, failure to meet support needs and psychological abuse*`



The most commonly reported type of abuse towards adults with disability (AWD) was failure to meet support needs, theft and withholding the person's money*`

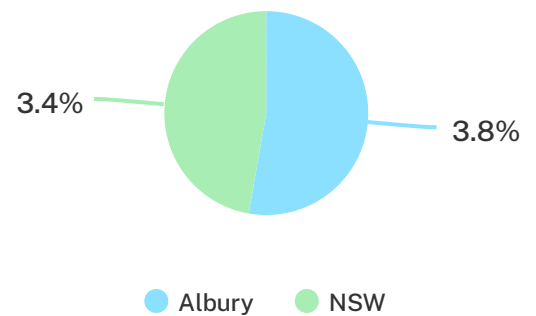

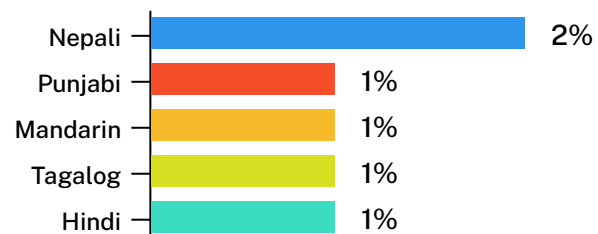
