
## **Coffs Harbour**



The Ageing and Disability Commission (ADC) received 110 reports of alleged abuse, neglect or exploitation of an older person or adult with disability from **Coffs Harbour** in 2019-2024\*.




The most commonly reported types of abuse towards older people (OP) were financial exploitation, verbal abuse and failure to meet support needs`

The most commonly reported types of abuse towards adults with disability (AWD) were verbal abuse, making excessive or degrading demands and other psychological abuse`




