
## **Armidale**



The Ageing and Disability Commission (ADC) received 125 reports of alleged abuse, neglect or exploitation of an older person or adult with disability from Armidale in 2019-2024\*.




Reports about adults with disability **most** commonly involved a parent\* as the subject of allegation



of reports about older people involved family members, mainly adult children followed by the adult's spouse or partner,\* as the subject of allegation



The most commonly reported types of abuse towards older people (OP) was financial exploitation, failure to meet support needs and verbal abuse`



The most commonly reported types of abuse towards adults with disability (AWD) was financial exploitation, failure to meet support needs and theft (taking person's money)




