

The Ageing and Disability Commission (ADC) received 60 reports of alleged abuse, neglect or exploitation of an older person or adult with disability from **Bellingen** in 2019-2024*.




Reports about adults with disability **most** commonly involved a parent* as the subject of allegation



of reports about older people involved family members, mainly adult children followed by the adult's spouse or partner,* as the subject of allegation



The most commonly reported types of abuse towards older people (OP) was failure to meet support needs, medical care and verbal abuse`



The most commonly reported types of abuse towards adults with disability (AWD) was financial exploitation, making excessive or degrading demands, and preventing or restricting access to supports or services`




