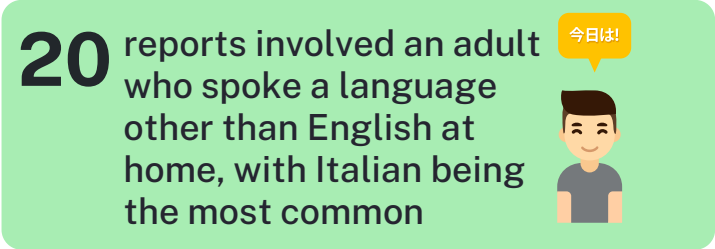
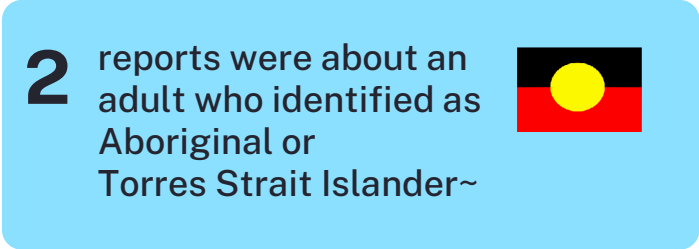
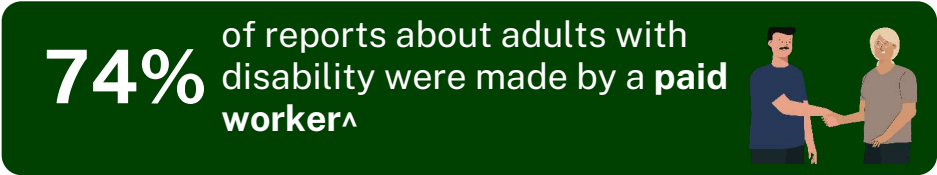
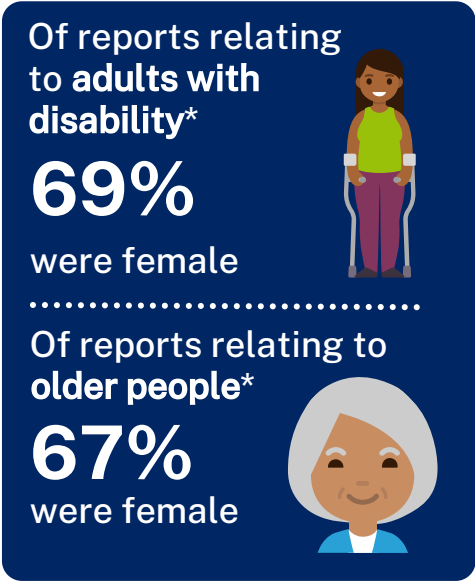
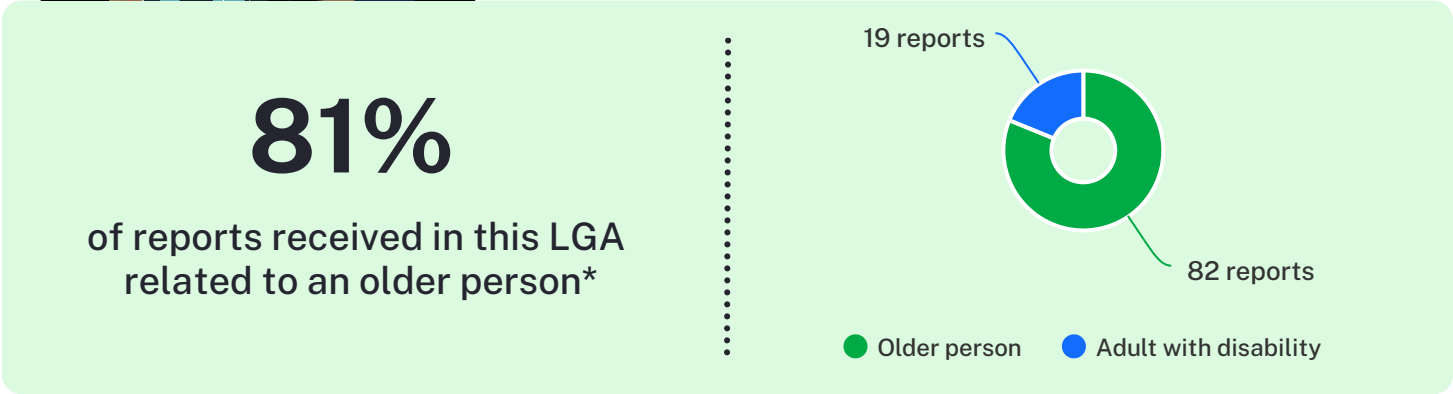


Ageing and Disability Commission Canada Bay

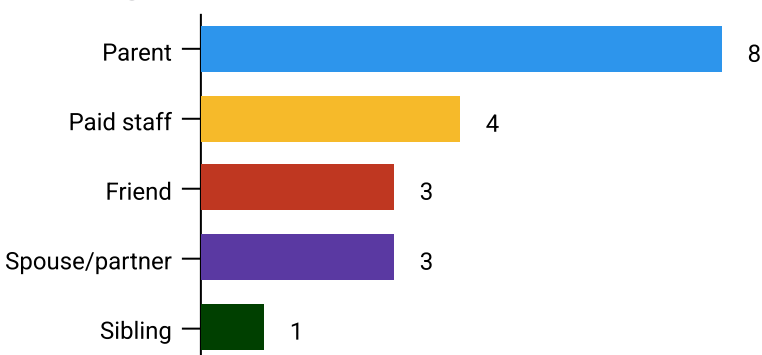


The Ageing and Disability Commission (ADC) received 101 reports of alleged abuse, neglect or exploitation of an older person or adult with disability from **Canada Bay** in 2019-2024*.



* Information taken from the Ageing and Disability Commission data on reports received between 1 July 2019 to 30 June 2024 where the location of the adult identified in the report was known.
^ Paid workers include people acting in a professional capacity, for example direct care staff, service workers and health providers.
~ People who identify as Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander and who are over 18 with disability, or an older person 50+.
The ADC is currently working on improving our data collection to support reporting on gender identity

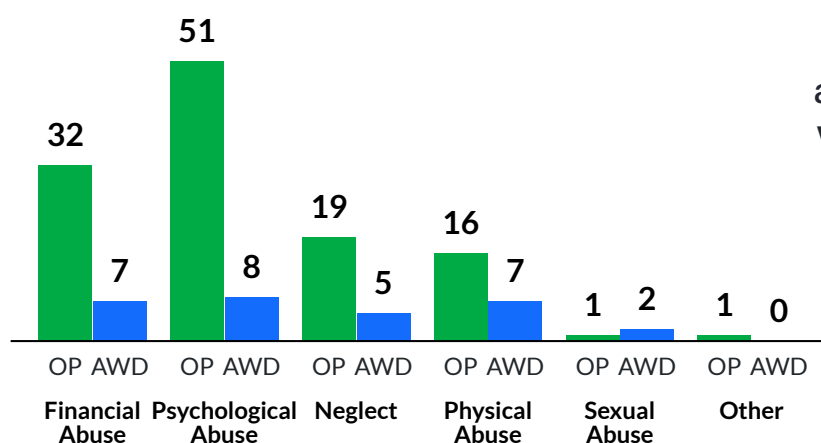
Reports about adults with disability **most commonly involved a parent*** as the subject of allegation



61% of reports about older people involved family members, **mainly adult children** followed by the adult's spouse or partner,* as the subject of allegation



The most commonly reported types of abuse towards **older people (OP)** was **verbal abuse, financial exploitation and preventing or restricting access to family or others**



The most commonly reported types of abuse towards **adults with disability (AWD)** was **financial exploitation, verbal abuse and inappropriate restraint or use of excessive force**

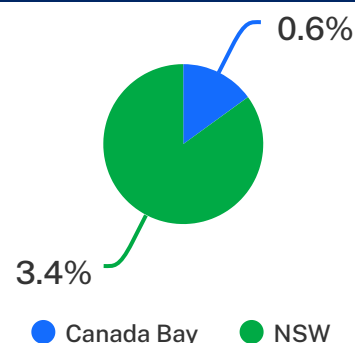

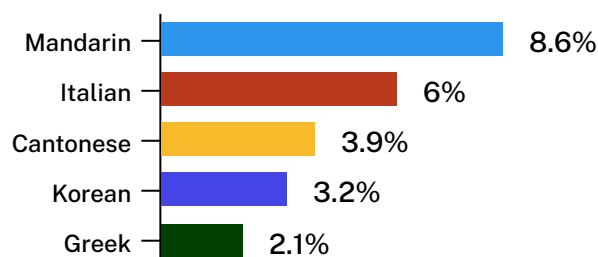
