
## **Cumberland**



The Ageing and Disability Commission (ADC) received 397 reports of alleged abuse, neglect or exploitation of an older person or adult with disability from Cumberland in 2019-2024\*.

of reports about adults with 65% disability were made by a paid



**36%** of reports about older people came from a paid worker^

78 reports involved an adult who spoke a language other than English at home with Arabic being the most common language reported




Reports about adults with disability **most** commonly involved a parent\* as the subject of allegation



of reports about older people involved family members, mainly adult children followed by paid staff,\* as the subject of allegation



The most commonly reported types of abuse towards older people (OP) was failure to meet support needs, verbal abuse and financial exploitation`



The most commonly reported types of abuse towards adults with disability (AWD) was failure to meet support needs, preventing or restricting access to supports or services and verbal abuse




