

The Ageing and Disability Commission (ADC) received 142 reports of alleged abuse, neglect or exploitation of an older person or adult with disability from **Dubbo** in 2019-2024*.




Reports about adults with disability **most commonly involved a parent*** as the subject of allegation



of reports about older people involved family members, mainly adult children followed by the adult's spouse or partner,* as the subject of allegation

The most commonly reported types of abuse towards adults with disability (AWD) was other psychological abuse, hitting, and verbal abuse*




