
## Goulburn Mulwaree



The Ageing and Disability Commission (ADC) received 78 reports of alleged abuse, neglect or exploitation of an older person or adult with disability from **Goulburn Mulwaree** in 2019-2024\*.




Reports about adults with disability most commonly involved a parent\* as the subject of allegation



61% of reports about older people involved family members, mainly adult children followed by a friend,\* as the subject of allegation



The most commonly reported types of abuse towards older people (OP) were verbal abuse. financial exploitation and preventing or restricting access to family or others`



The most commonly reported types of abuse towards adults with disability (AWD) were failure to meet support needs, preventing or restricting access to supports or services and verbal abuse




