

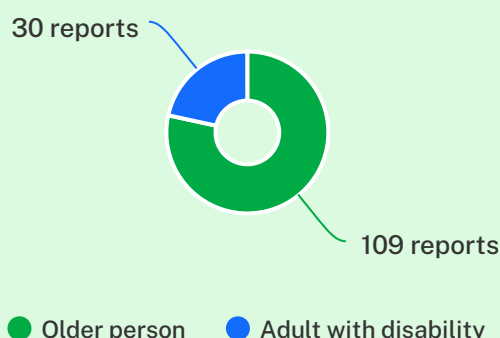
Ageing and Disability Commission Hawkesbury



The Ageing and Disability Commission (ADC) received 139 reports of alleged abuse, neglect or exploitation of an older person or adult with disability from **Hawkesbury** in 2019-2024*.

73% of reports about adults with disability were made by a **paid worker**[^]



31% of reports came from the **child** of the older person

30% of reports about **older people** came from a **paid worker**[^]

8% of reports came from the **spouse or partner**



6 reports were about an adult who identified as Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander~



2 reports involved an adult who spoke a language other than English at home, with Croatian being the most common language reported

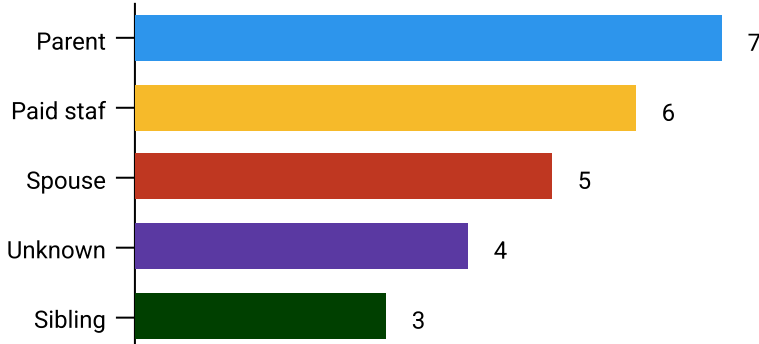

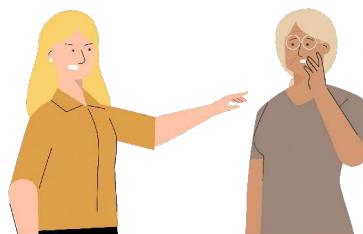

The ADC is currently working on improving our data collection to support reporting on gender identity

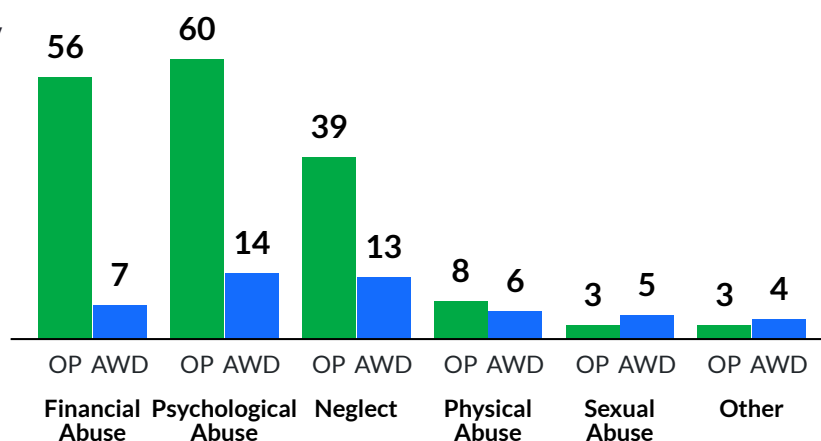
Reports about adults with disability **most commonly involved a parent*** as the subject of allegation



47% of reports about older people involved family members, **mainly adult children** followed by the adult's spouse or partner,* as the subject of allegation



The most commonly reported types of abuse towards **older people (OP)** was **financial exploitation, failure to meet support needs and verbal abuse**



The most commonly reported types of abuse towards **adults with disability (AWD)** was **restricting access to supports or services, verbal abuse and medical care**

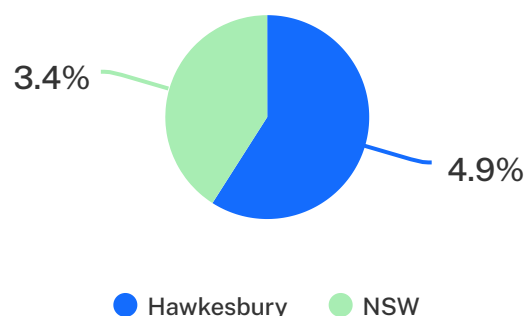

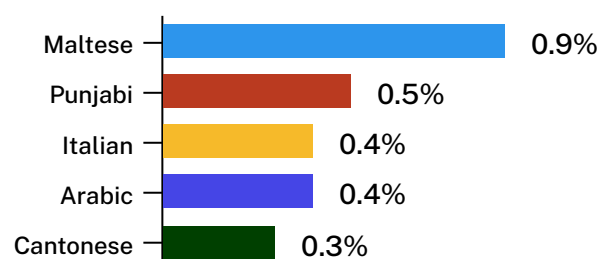
