

The Ageing and Disability Commission (ADC) received 127 reports of alleged abuse, neglect or exploitation of an older person or adult with disability from **Kiama** in 2019-2024*.




Reports about adults with disability **most** commonly involved paid staff* as the subject of allegation



of reports about older people involved family members, mainly adult children followed by the adult's spouse or partner,* as the subject of allegation



The most commonly reported types of abuse towards older people (OP) were financial exploitation, failure to meet support needs and verbal abuse`



The most commonly reported types of abuse towards adults with disability (AWD) were medical care, other psychological abuse and preventing or restricting access to supports of services




