

# Ageing and Disability Commission Kiama

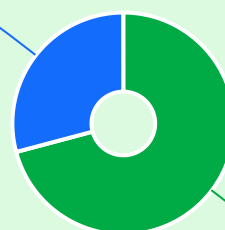


The Ageing and Disability Commission (ADC) received 127 reports of alleged abuse, neglect or exploitation of an older person or adult with disability from **Kiama** in 2019-2024\*.

**71%**

of reports received in this LGA related to an older person\*

37 reports

Of reports relating to **adults with disability\***

**54%**

were male



Of reports relating to **older people\***

**62%**

were female



**54%** of reports about adults with disability were made by a **paid worker**^



**31%** of reports about **older people** came from a **paid worker**^

**22%** of reports came from the **child of the older person**

**12%** of reports came from the **older person** experiencing abuse



**0** reports were about an adult who identified as Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander~



**2** reports involved an adult who spoke a language other than English at home, with Italian being the most common language reported

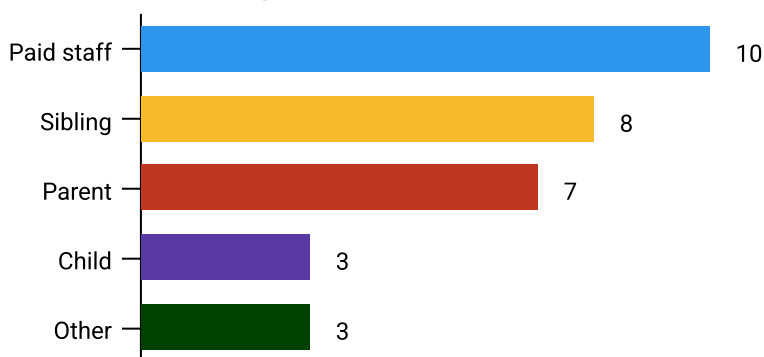
^ Paid workers include people acting in a professional capacity, for example direct care staff, service workers and health providers.

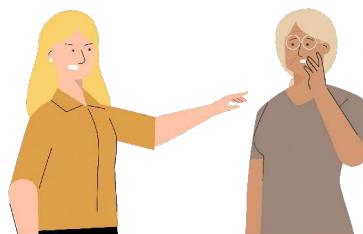
The ADC is currently working on improving our data collection to support reporting on gender identity

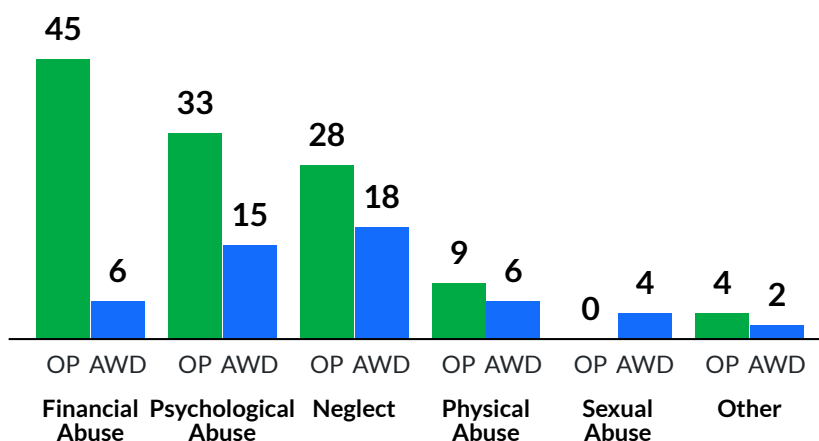
Reports about adults with disability **most commonly involved paid staff\*** as the subject of allegation



**60%** of reports about older people involved family members, **mainly adult children** followed by the adult's spouse or partner,\* as the subject of allegation



The most commonly reported types of abuse towards **older people (OP)** were **financial exploitation, failure to meet support needs and verbal abuse**



The most commonly reported types of abuse towards **adults with disability (AWD)** were **medical care, other psychological abuse and preventing or restricting access to supports of services**

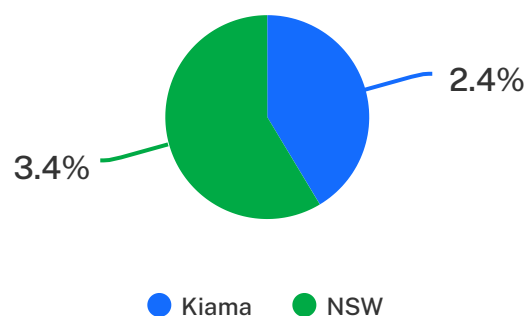

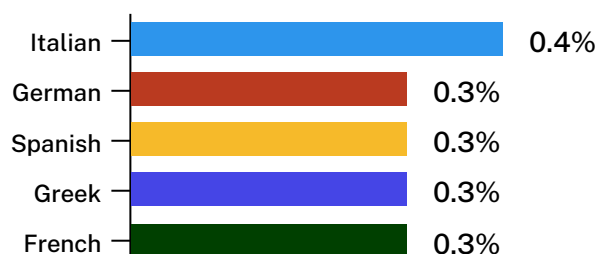
