
## Lithgow



The Ageing and Disability Commission (ADC) received 69 reports of alleged abuse, neglect or exploitation of an older person or adult with disability from **Lithgow** in 2019-2024\*.




Reports about adults with disability **most** commonly involved the adult's child\* as the subject of allegation



of reports about older people involved family members, mainly adult children followed by the adult's spouse or partner,\* as the subject of allegation



The most commonly reported types of abuse towards older people (OP) was verbal abuse, failure to meet support needs and financial exploitation`



The most commonly reported types of abuse towards adults with disability (AWD) was financial abuse, perceived threat of harm and preventing access to or withholding Person's money




