
## Liverpool



The Ageing and Disability Commission (ADC) received 256 reports of alleged abuse, neglect or exploitation of an older person or adult with disability from **Liverpool** in 2019-2024\*.

of reports received in this LGA related to an older person\*

were female

68% were female

of reports about adults with disability were made by a paid worker^



**34%** of reports about older people came from a paid worker^

32% of reports came from the child of the older person

reports involved an adult who spoke a language other than English at home with Vietnamese being the most common language reported




Reports about adults with disability **most** commonly involved a parent\* as the subject of allegation



of reports about older people involved family members, mainly adult children followed by the adult's spouse or partner,\* as the subject of allegation



The most commonly reported types of abuse towards older people (OP) was verbal abuse, failure to meet support needs and financial exploitation`



The most commonly reported types of abuse towards adults with disability (AWD) was failure to meet support needs, preventing or restricting access to supports and verbal abuse


