
## Port Macquarie-Hastings



The Ageing and Disability Commission (ADC) received 242 reports of alleged abuse, neglect or exploitation of an older person or adult with disability from **Port Macquarie-Hastings** in 2019-2024\*.

reports involved an adult who spoke a language other than English at home with Italian being the most common language reported




Reports about adults with disability **most**commonly involved a parent\* as the subject
of allegation



of reports about older people involved family members, mainly adult children followed by the adult's spouse or partner,\* as the subject of allegation

The most commonly reported types of abuse towards adults with disability (AWD) was verbal abuse, preventing or restricting access to supports to services and financial exploitation`
