

The Ageing and Disability Commission (ADC) received 140 reports of alleged abuse, neglect or exploitation of an older person or adult with disability from Port Stephens in 2019-2024*.




The most commonly reported types of abuse towards older people (OP) was verbal abuse, financial exploitation and preventing or restricting access to family or others`




