

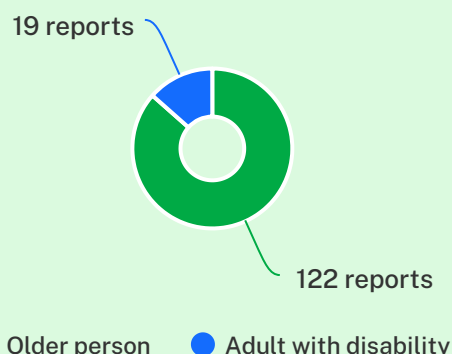
Ageing and Disability Commission Randwick



The Ageing and Disability Commission (ADC) received 141 reports of alleged abuse, neglect or exploitation of an older person or adult with disability from **Randwick** in 2019-2024*.

87%

of reports received in this LGA related to an older person*



Of reports relating to **adults with disability***

58%

were male



Of reports relating to **older people***

71%

were female



53% of reports about adults with disability were made by a **paid worker**^



24% of reports about **older people** came from a **paid worker**^

17% of reports were made by the **older person** experiencing abuse



16% of reports came from the **child of the older person**

3 reports were about an adult who identified as Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander~



17 reports involved an adult who spoke a language other than English at home, with Greek being the most common language reported

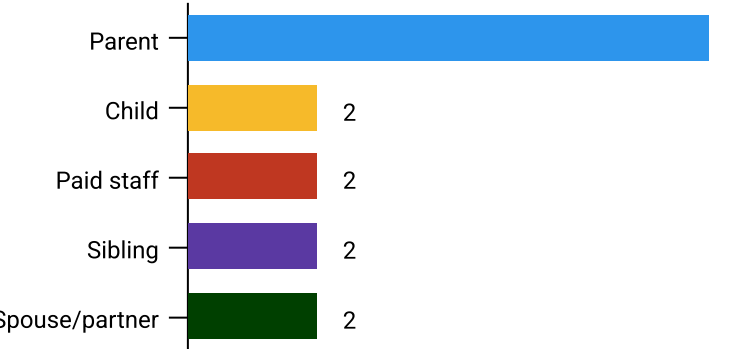

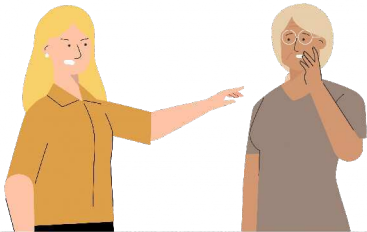

The ADC is currently working on improving our data collection to support reporting on gender identity

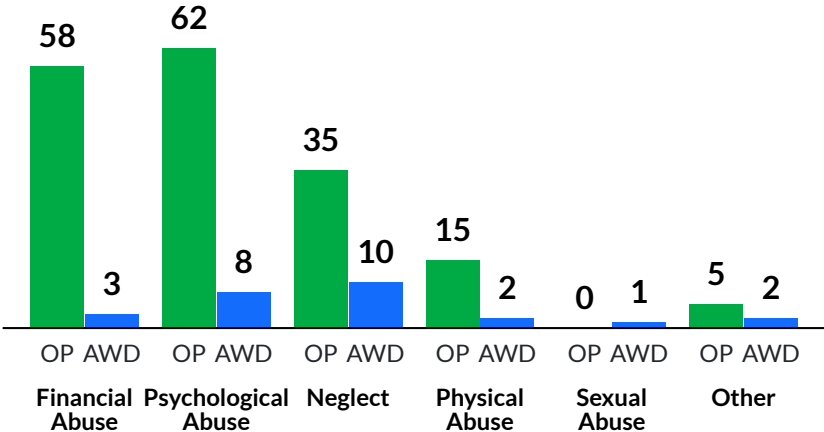
Reports about adults with disability **most commonly involved a parent*** as the subject of allegation



48% of reports about older people involved family members, **mainly adult children** followed by a friend,* as the subject of allegation



The most commonly reported types of abuse towards **older people (OP)** was **verbal abuse, financial exploitation and failure to meet support needs'**



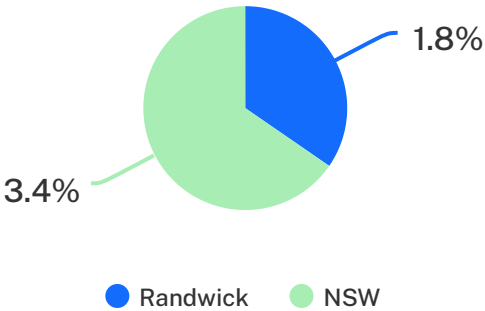
The most commonly reported types of abuse towards **adults with disability (AWD)** was **failure to meet support needs, medical care and restricting access to supports or services***

What else do we know about the Randwick community?

16% of the population are over the age of 65.



1.8% of the population identified as Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander¹



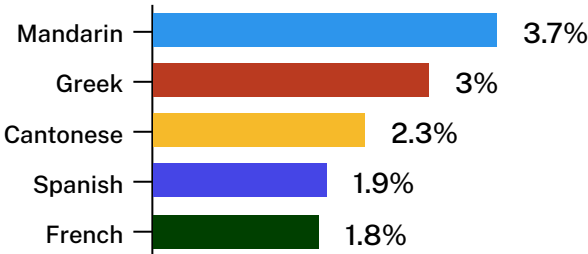
65% of all households are family households **29%** are single person households and **8%** are group households²



34% of households speak a language other than English²



Mandarin is the most common language other than English²
