

The Ageing and Disability Commission (ADC) received 291 reports of alleged abuse, neglect or exploitation of an older person or adult with disability from **Shoalhaven** in 2019-2024*.




52% of reports about older people involved family members, mainly adult children followed by the adult's spouse or partner,* as the subject of allegation

The most commonly reported types of abuse towards adults with disability (AWD) was failure to meet support needs. verbal abuse and financial exploitation`




