
Ageing and Disability Commission Sutherland Shire



The Ageing and Disability Commission (ADC) received 306 reports of alleged abuse, neglect or exploitation of an older person or adult with disability from **Sutherland Shire** in 2019-2024*.

of reports about older people involved family members, mainly adult children followed by the adult's spouse or partner,* as the subject of allegation




The most commonly reported types of abuse towards older people (OP) was financial exploitation, verbal abuse and failure to meet support needs`


The most commonly reported types of abuse towards adults with disability (AWD) was other psychological abuse, verbal abuse and making excessive or degrading demands`


