
## **Tamworth**



The Ageing and Disability Commission (ADC) received 97 reports of alleged abuse, neglect or exploitation of an older person or adult with disability from **Tamworth** in 2019-2024\*.


Reports about adults with disability most commonly involved a spouse or partner\* as the subject of allegation

63% of reports about older people involved family members, mainly adult children followed by the adult's spouse or partner,\* as the subject of allegation



The most commonly reported types of abuse towards older people (OP) was verbal abuse. failure to meet support needs and financial exploitation`



The most commonly reported types of abuse towards adults with disability (AWD) was financial exploitation, failure to meet support needs and , hitting, kicking or punching




