
Ageing and Disability Commission Waverley



The Ageing and Disability Commission (ADC) received 115 reports of alleged abuse, neglect or exploitation of an older person or adult with disability from **Waverley** in 2019-2024*.




Reports about adults with disability **most** commonly involved a neigbour* as the subject of allegation



50% of reports about older people involved family members, mainly adult children followed by the adult's spouse or partner,* as the subject of allegation



The most commonly reported types of abuse towards older people (OP) were failure to meet support needs, financial exploitation and preventing or restricting access to family or others`




The most commonly reported types of abuse towards adults with disability (AWD) were verbal abuse. failure to meet support needs and financial exploitation`


