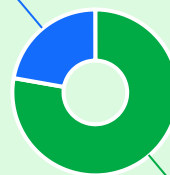


The Ageing and Disability Commission (ADC) received 513 reports of alleged abuse, neglect or exploitation of an older person or adult with disability from the **New England** region in 2019-2024*.

62% of reports about adults with disability were made by a **paid worker**^



33% of reports about **older people** came from a **paid worker**^

19% of reports came from the **child** of the older person



15% of reports came from the **older person** experiencing abuse

36 reports were about an adult who identified as Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander~



3 reports involved an adult who spoke a language other than English at home with Arabic being the most common language reported

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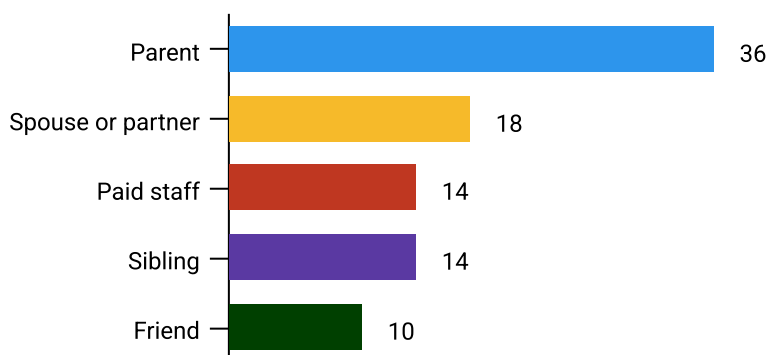

The ADC is currently working on improving our data collection to support reporting on gender identity

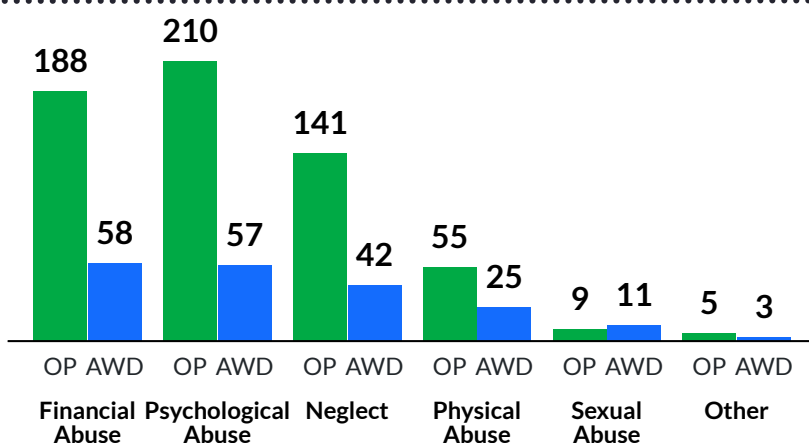
Reports about adults with disability **most commonly involved a parent*** as the subject of allegation



53% of reports about older people involved family members, **mainly adult children** followed by the adult's spouse or partner,* as the subject of allegation



The most commonly reported types of abuse towards **older people (OP)** was **financial exploitation, verbal abuse, and failure to meet support needs**



The most commonly reported types of abuse towards **adults with disability (AWD)** was **failure to meet support needs, financial exploitation and verbal abuse**

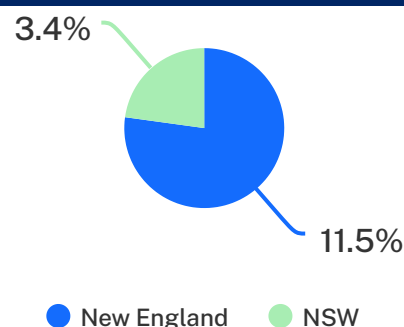

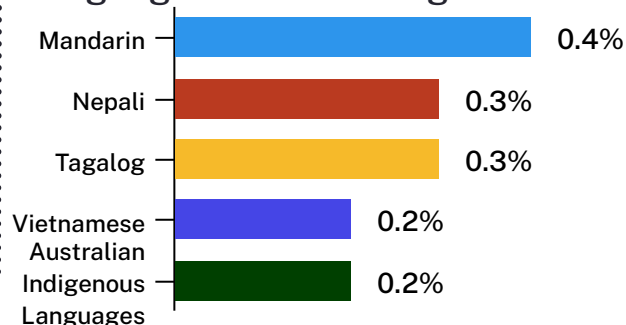
