

The Ageing and Disability Commission (ADC) received 1172 reports of alleged abuse, neglect or exploitation of an older person or adult with disability from the **Northern Sydney** region in 2019-2024\*.






Reports about adults with disability **most** commonly involved a parent\* as the subject of allegation

The most commonly reported types of abuse towards older people (OP) was verbal abuse, financial exploitation, and failure to meet support needs`




The most commonly reported types of abuse towards adults with disability (AWD) was verbal abuse, failure to meet support needs, and financial exploitation`


