The Ageing & Disability Commission (ADC) received 57 reports related to allegations or concerns of abuse, neglect or exploitation of an older person or adult with disability from **Liverpool** in 2020\*.




Reports about adults with disability **most commonly involved community and family members\*** as the subject of allegation.
